Public speaking can fulfill the purpose of transmitting information, telling a story, motivating people to act or encouraging people. This type of speech is deliberately structured with three general purposes: to inform, to persuade and to entertain. Knowing when public speaking is most effective and how it is done properly are key to understanding the importance of it.

For this purpose the course was initiated in the college from 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 to 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2020. In this course the students were 19 students enrolled by circulating the notice of the same in all the programs run by the college. In this course the students were taught the meaning of 'Public Speaking', the types, process, the requirements for delivering speech etc. The course was made interesting by allowing the students to speak on the subject of their choice in front of the student audience earlier. Due to which they developed confidence and courage to face the crowd. Later the students were given the topics from various categories such as Demonstrative speech, Informative speech, Occasion speech, Persuasive speech etc.


In this course, 16 students were appeared for the exams. After that exam session or evaluation was scheduled on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020. For judging, the students were instructed to make videos on the below mentioned topics. In between the course students were told to prepare the assignments too. And likewise the score sheet was prepared. All this was done online as the college was closed due to the ongoing pandemic.

The students participated in the competition with great enthusiasm. The duration of 5 mins was given for speech.



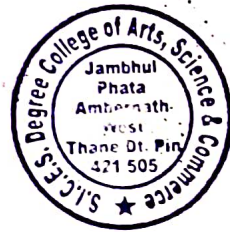
Awareness program on “**MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AND CERVICAL CANCER**”
