For Annual Report:

BBI is a full-time degree course spread over 3 years, with each year being divided into 2 semesters. The course covers 39 subjects and 1 project on banking and insurance of 100 marks each, which are to be submitted in the 6th semester of final year. The class strength of 60 is optimal, since it allows for better student-teacher interaction and participation. The course is very professionally and effectively conducted, with highly qualified academics and professionals conducting the classes.

The teaching methodology includes classroom discussions and debates, role play, case studies and paper presentations, in addition to the conventional chalk-and-talk method. While the course is primarily theoretical, there is a good **blend of projects, case studies** and **industrial visits** to enable a student to get hands on experience in the functioning of the Industry. The department also conducts various guidance lectures, seminars and workshops to make them well – versed in global Banking and Insurance markets.

In addition to the above activities, the department arranges an orientation for the parents and students of the first year, a graduation ceremony for the third year and regular parent teacher meets for defaulters and weak students of all the three years to keep parents abreast of the performance of their ward.
