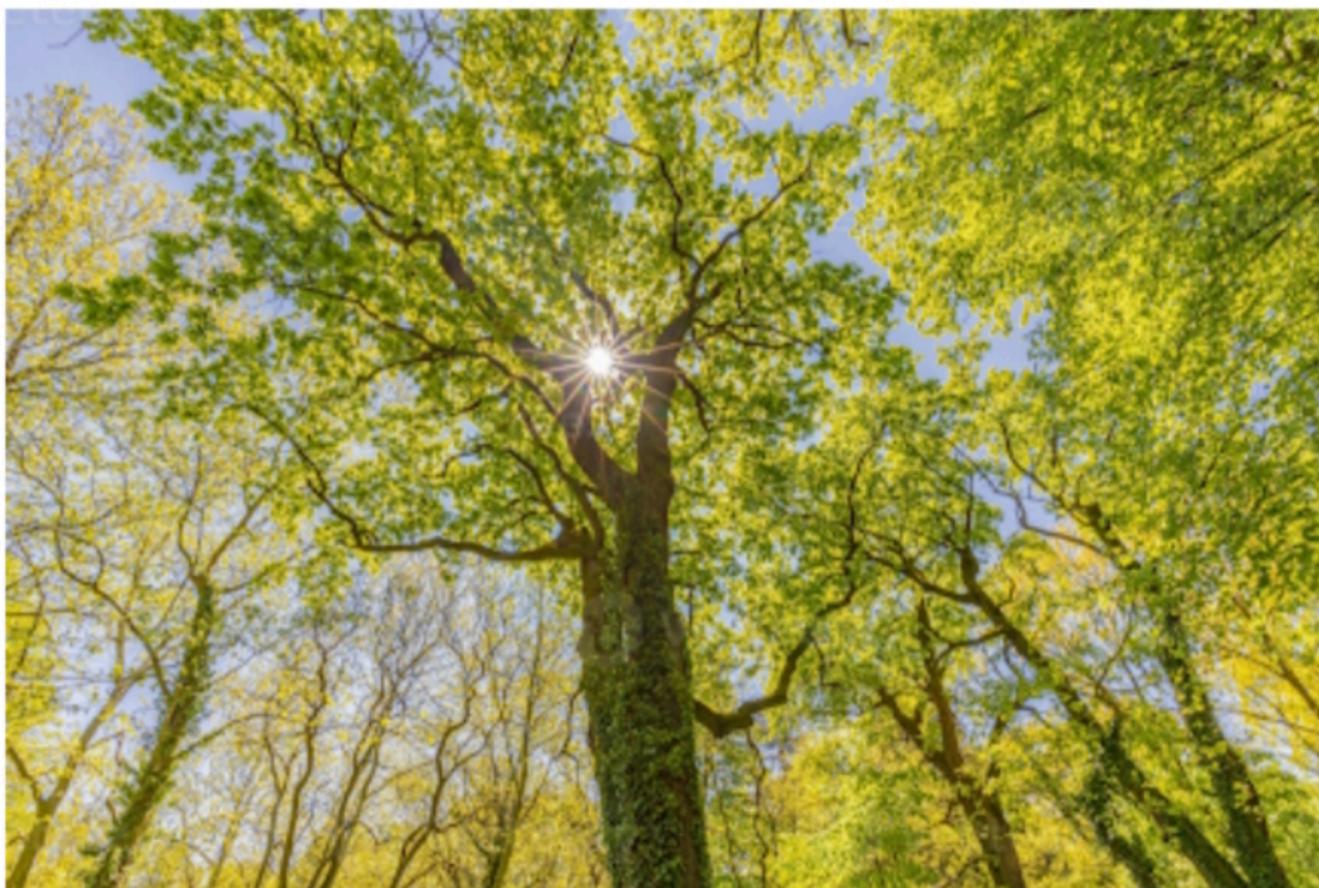
## Nature's Geometry and Chaos

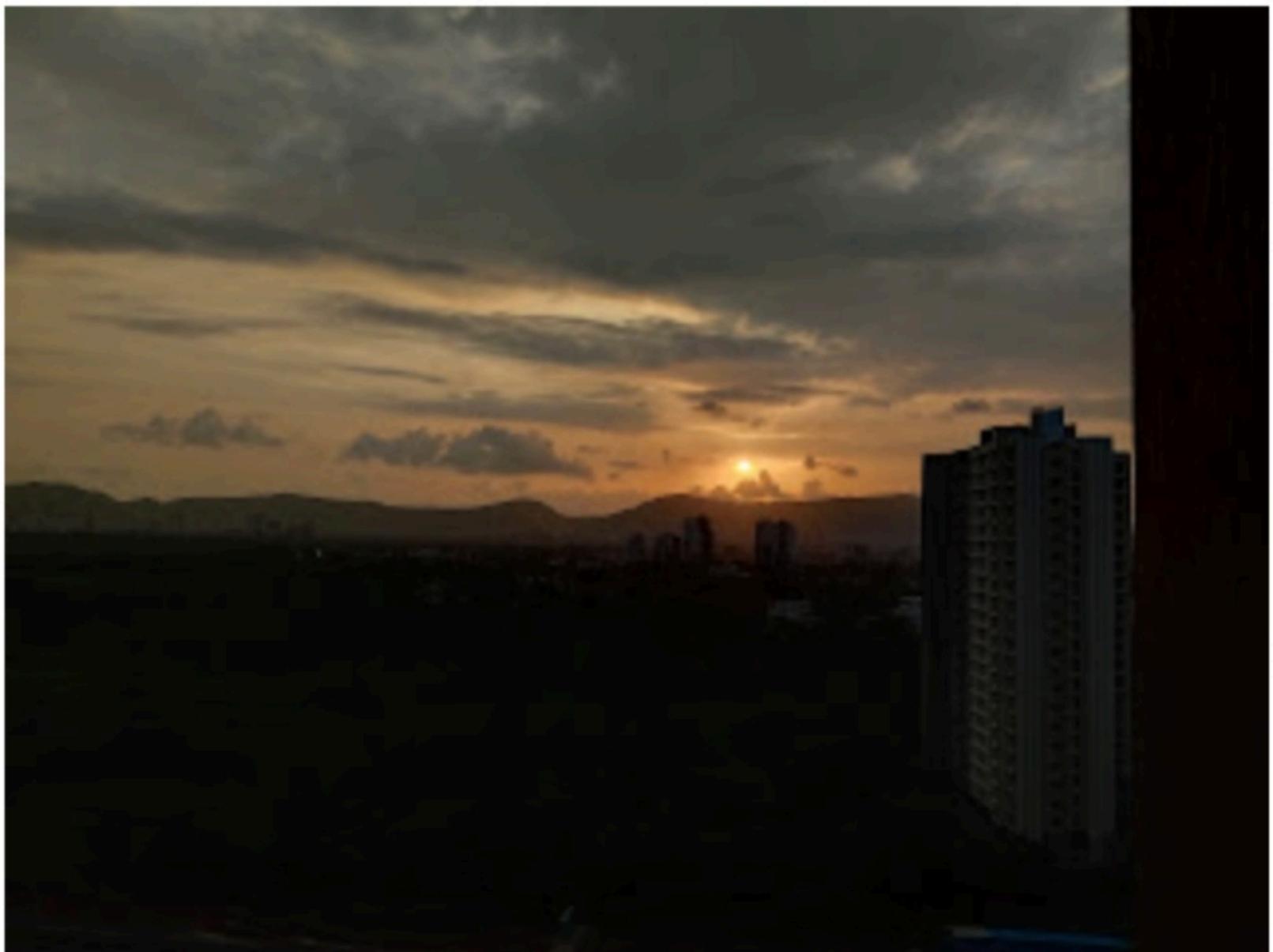


## Beauty of Nature - The Hug of Homecoming
