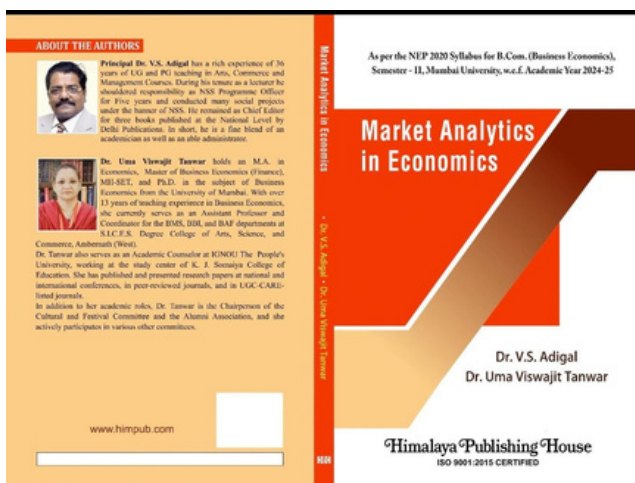
## **"Asst. Prof. Dr. Uma Tanwar Publishes Book on Marketing Analytics in Economics "**

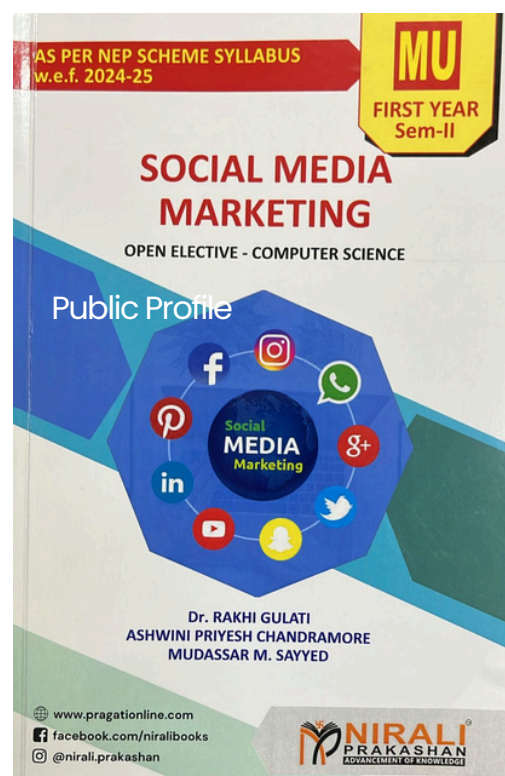
## **"Assistant Professor Mudassar Mehbul Sayyed Authors Two Academic Books for Commerce and Management Students"**

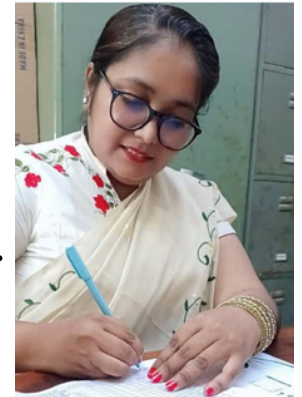

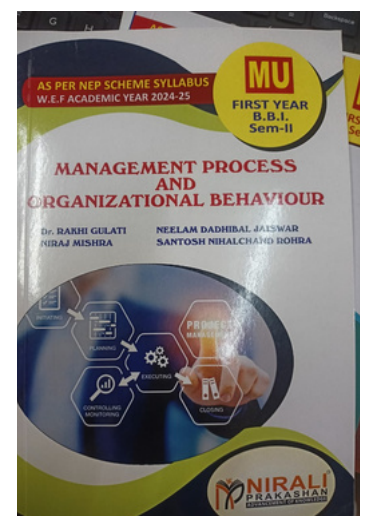
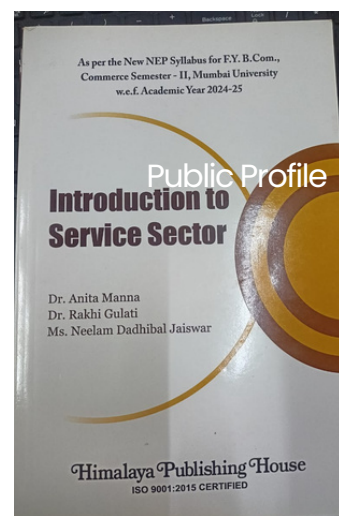
## **"Assistant Professor Neelam Jaiswar Successfully Defends Ph.D. Viva at University of Mumbai"**

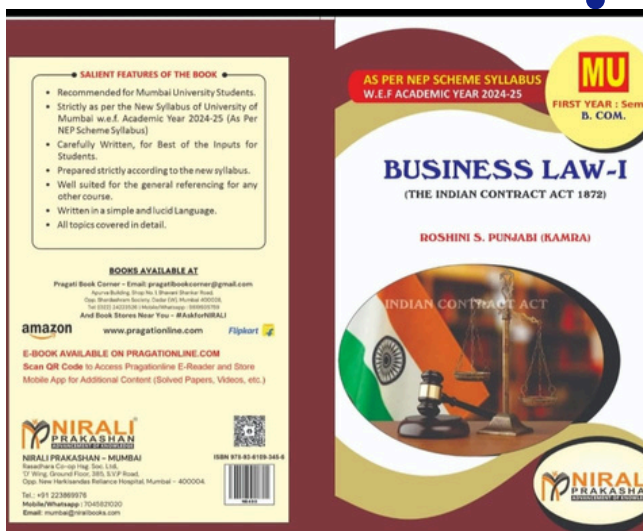
## **"Advocate & Assistant Professor Ms. Roshni S. Punjabi-Kamra d Authors Academic Books for Commerce "**
